

Purpose and Goal:

College Now seeks to boost college completion rates with its Mentoring Program, which matches approximately 350 freshmen scholarship recipients with professionals in the community. Mentors stay with their mentees for four years, helping them navigate any obstacle that may prevent them from graduating.

Structure:

- Convenient: Pairs communicate over an online platform and receive talking points monthly
- Effective: Matches are created based on shared career and academic interests and hobbies
- Inclusive: Mentors have the chance to connect with each other at several yearly events

Results:

96% of Mentoring Program participants continue on to their second year of college, compared to 58% nationally for students from low-income backgrouds.

- Communicate twice a month over an online platform
